Village Front Entrance Committee

The original idea was to create a low maintenance horticultural, low profile, lighted small stone or brick curved fence/wall with evergreen horticultural interest that would reflect the historical architectural features of The Village while creating a distinct yet minimal entrance marker — similar to the entrance to various wineries around the region. This project was motivated by the pride so many of the residents take in living in The Village.

Much appreciation is sent to Mona Babin, Gloria-Lindsay Luby and John Hawley for our initial meeting on December 3, 2020 to discuss the possibility and interest in creating a welcoming distinctive entrance. Since that time, no other interest has been expressed, so while we believe the idea has merit, it will take the efforts of a larger committee to work with the town and the region for approvals.

As of April 2021, I am stepping back from the initiative for now, leaving the idea on the table.

This map was supplied by Kevin Turcotte, NOTL's Manager of Parks & Recreation, and defines town land in The Village. The entrance marker would be located on town property on the north east corner of The Village entrance from Niagara Stone Road.
