Treasurer's Report

Highlights 2020-2021 Joe Allevato

As of March 31, 2021, The Village Community Association had unencumbered funds totalling \$6,379.52. Net operating surplus for the year was \$420.13.

Total membership revenue was \$3,810. That revenue is intended to pay for general administration, website fees, insurance and Village holiday decorating.

Here is a brief summary:

- The above loss was augmented by a surplus from Golf Day social committee event of \$885.

- We also thank Niagara-on-the-Lake Hydro for their donation of the VCA hydro bill for last year.
