1. Wildlife in The Village

2. Nomination Committee

In accordance with our by-laws (see below), a nominating committee shall be formed:

a) At the October meeting of the Association, the Executive Board shall appoint three (3) members as a nominating committee to prepare a slate of nominees consisting of at least one (1) candidate for each Executive Board position up for re-election. This slate shall be presented at the Annual General Meeting for election of the new Executive Board. Nominations from the floor will also be accepted at the Annual General Meeting. Voting members of the nominating committee are not barred from becoming nominees for office. If more than one candidate is running for an Executive Board position, the vote shall be by secret ballot.

Positions which are up for election at the Annual General Meeting in April 2024:

- Vice-President
- Recording Officer
- Treasurer

Any residents who are interested in participating on the Nominating Committee can reach out to me ahead of the General Meeting.
