#### 1. Little Libraries

The Little Libraries are functioning very well in both locations. The turnover of books as well as the variety has been wonderful - especially welcomed during this long cold winter! We have asked that no magazines be placed in the Libraries as they do not stand up well (literally!). We know that our Libraries have visitors from other locations beyond The Village and we welcome this!

## 2. Lighting on the Pathway to the Ravine

The process of signing the joint land use agreement between the Town and the Conservation Authority is in the hands of the Town's legal department and is progressing slowly. Current timeline indicates this will be completed by May, 2022.

## 3. **Replanting in the Ravine**

The Conservation Authority is planning to begin the preparation and replanting process in late April to early May. We will be working with them to engage interested Village residents in assisting in the planting process - they will be attending our Community Day on April 25 and will likely have a sign-up process in place there. We are excited to work with them in restoring the Ravine to a prettier environment and to learn more about the process of renewal.
